



## Buggy, Electric & Manual Trolley Usage Policy

### Introduction

The aim of the Club as a general principle is to make every effort to enable as many of our members as possible to play the course whatever the conditions. However, there will be a need to balance this aim to provide maximum access with the need to protect the course from undue damage which is in the best interest of all the members.

There will also be restrictions on buggy use where Health and Safety is the overriding concern.

In addition, when placing restrictions on buggy and electric trolley use it is recognised that special consideration has to be given to the needs of the disabled as required by the 2010 Equality Act. This and other measures in support of the disabled are set out in a separate document entitled 'Windlesham Golf Club's Commitment to the Disabled'.

We will be introducing a new Traffic Light System Buggy & Trolley Status that all golfers will be required to follow as conditions of the course change and this system is reflected below:

<b>Buggies</b>	Holes 1-18	Holes 1-9 on Pathways + Holes 10-18	Holes 1-9 on Pathways ONLY Walk 90 degrees
<b>Electric Trolleys <u>without</u> Winter wheels</b>	Holes 1-18	Holes 1-9 on Pathways + Holes 10-18	Holes 1-9 on Pathway ONLY Walk 90 degrees
<b>Manual/Pull &amp; Electric Trolleys <u>with</u> Winter wheels</b>	Holes 1-18	Holes 1-18	Holes 1-18

### Full Buggy Ban

Under exceptional circumstances the condition of the course may be such that for safety reasons a full buggy ban has to be introduced.

### Course Protection and User Safety

Designated routes will be established for buggies on a hole by hole basis to enable safe access and to minimise wear and tear.

### Buggy User Safety

All buggy users will be required to complete a 'Golf Buggy Safety Policy Acknowledgement' form.

### Communication

The Club will endeavour to advise members of any restrictions as soon as possible. The Club's Twitter feed will reflect the current status as will notices displayed at the club. But if any doubt exists, members are requested to contact the pro shop.
